OUR GUIDE TO SPIRITUAL WARFARE

1 Peter 5:6-14

CONNECT:

In our text this week our enemy is likened to a roaring lion. With that said, share with the group your favorite zoo to visit. What are your favorite animals to see when you visit a zoo and why?

GROW:

What was the biggest takeaway for you from today's text and why?

How is the Devil like a lion and what tactics does he use to devour Christians? How do you practice watchfulness and sober mindedness in your daily experience of spiritual warfare? How do lost people factor into this spiritual war?

How does knowing that other Christians are suffering persecution help to strengthen you to resist the enemy? How does Peter's future promise in verse 10 encourage you to fight the good fight of faith where you are right now?

This is our final week in 1 Peter. Peter has sought to equip us to live in a hostile world. What will be your biggest takeaway from your time in 1 Peter and why?

SERVE:

Consider ways to serve someone in your Life Group this week or how your Life Group can serve someone else this week.

MULTIPLY:

One of Peter's final instructions to us is that we would stand firm in his teaching. What is one practical thing you can do this week to stand more firm in something that you have learned in 1 Peter? What is one practical way you can help another Christ-follower to do the same?
